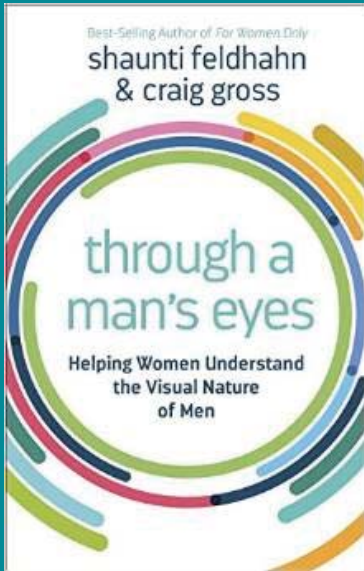
Invite your group to take on the 30-Day Kindness Challenge!
